





WHAT INSURANCE DO YOU HAVE?

Shearwater has public liability insurance of \$2m USD, underwritten by Lloyds of London in place for all activities.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Wear neutral colours (no bright colours), with comfortable walking shoes. The mornings and evenings can be chilly so bring something warm to wear.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

A camera and binoculars. Warm clothing and, if during the rainy season, a rain jacket.


WHAT SHOULD I LEAVE BEHIND?

Any valuables and food.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE TRIP?

For morning walks guests get a breakfast of Tea/Coffee and water and with a side of freshly baked muffins. For the afternoon game drives dry snacks, beers, soft drinks and water are served. For the evening game drive a three course dinner is served.

We also include a fleece poncho to keep you warm in the winter and/or early mornings.

WALK IN THE ZAMBEZI NATIONAL PARK.

This active and interactive way to view game, allows you to interact with nature in a way that game drive don't. You will get to examine and follow animal tracks, see creatures up close and appreciate the amazing flora that covers the land. Being on foot lets you into a world so few get to see, hear, touch and smell Africa's flora and fauna up close and personal.

You will have ample opportunities to observe and photograph wildlife as we walk through Zambezi National Park, home to four of the Big Five, along with a diverse array of other game species. We will stop to point out birds, flora, fauna and animal tracks. Our guides will regale you with stories of the bush, they'll let you know which plants you can use for toilet paper, how you can tell the age of an elephant dung and what branch to use to brush your teeth.

The activity will start with a pick-up from your Victoria Falls hotels, we'll drive you to the Zambezi National Park

(about 15 minutes) and then we will find a spot to start the walk.

Frequently asked questions

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT TO SEE?

Although we can't guarantee sightings we often see elephants, buffalos, giraffe, hippo, several species of plains game. While less common we have seen lions and leopards. Guides will also talk to guests about the vegetation and the 449 bird species in the Zambezi National Park - A premium bird watching destination.

IS THERE AN AGE LIMIT?

Th eparticipanst must be 12 years of age or older to join the trip.

ARE THERE AN RESTRICTIONS ON NUMBERS?

For the game walk we take a maximum of 10 people. A game walk needs at least two passengers to take place.

WHO ARE THE GUIDES?

We use only the best Zimbabwean professional guides and Zimbabwean guides are some of the best in the world. The process to become a professional guide (and qualified to lead walking safaris) takes four years of training. All our professional guides are licensed to carry a firearm and do so on the walking safaris. Guides also carry a first aid kit and a radio to communicate with Shearwater HQ.
